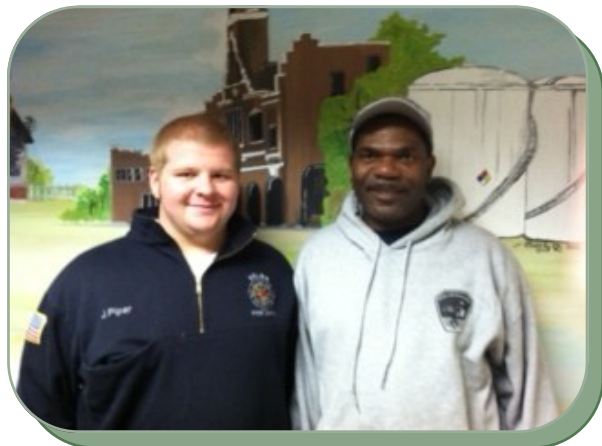

PREVENT HOME COOKING FIRES

Did you know that 1 in 8 households will have a cooking fire each year? The leading cause of fires in a home is unattended cooking.

Things to remember to help reduce the chances of having a cooking fire.

- * Never leave cooking unattended
- * Stay alert to your surroundings
 - Don't cook if you are feeling drowsy, or under the influence of a controlled substance
 - Know what to do if you have a cooking fire - cover the pot with a lid
 - Use baking soda or an approved fire extinguisher
- * Keep kids away from the stove
 - Never hold a child while you are cooking
 - Never allow children to cook unattended

Always remember to have a working smoking detector in your home. If you need a smoke detector the Selma Fire Department will provide you with a detector free of charge & help you install it. Contact the fire house at 965-2697 for any more details.

Town of Selma will be hosting a Targeted Service Area (TSA) meeting on Monday, March 26, 2012 at 5:15 PM at Brack Wilson Park, 1118 West Oak Street for TSA 1 & 2. This includes residents in the River Road area out to Buffalo Road, including Wynbrooke Subdivision, Hunting Ridge Mobile Home Park and River Oaks Apartments. Residents up to Brevard Street and Third Avenue are included as well. These meetings allow citizens to discuss with town leaders their concerns specific to their neighborhoods.
