**DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY
IN THE TOWN OF SELMA**

WHEREAS, the impacts of Hurricane Florence are anticipated to be felt in the Town of Selma; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above anticipated storm event, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the Town of Selma under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Article IV Sec. 2-90. – Emergency Management; Emergency responsibilities and function of the Town of Selma Code of Ordinances:

Section 1. A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of the Town of Selma.

Section 2. The emergency area covered by this state of emergency shall be within the entire Town of Selma.

Section 3. The following restrictions and prohibitions are imposed:


Section 4. I hereby order all Town law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the Town of Selma Emergency Operations Plan.

Section 5. I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with Clerk to the Town of Selma Town Council and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.


Section 6. This declaration shall take effect on September 11, 2018 at NOON and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
