

# Bulk Item Collection

Bulk Items are collected Monday Mornings for all residents within the Town of Selma.

**To schedule a bulk item pick up, call Town Hall at 919-965-9841.**

**\*\*Note: If you call after 9AM on Monday, your bulk items will be scheduled for pick up the next Monday.\*\***



- **What is considered a bulk item?**
  - Bulk items are considered household furniture, mattresses, box springs, love seats, couches and sofas.  
**\*\*Note: Bulk Items with Bed Bugs will not be picked up.\*\***
- **What is NOT considered a bulk Item?**
  - The Town of Selma does **NOT** pick-up appliances/electronics.
  - **Two household appliances per week** (Refrigerators, computers, dryers, washers, televisions, etc.) may be dropped off at the **Jones Brothers Convenience Center** located on North Brightleaf Blvd/US301 (near Chick-fil-A). Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **How many bulk items can I place at the curb for pickup?**
  - One hopper-full of furniture, which is about the size of two love seats or a mattress and box spring, will be picked-up on Monday.
  - There is a \$150 fee for the Town to haul excessive amounts of household furnishings. Any quantity of household furnishings with a volume larger than the hopper of the garbage truck will result in the property owner being charged a hauling fee by the Town.
- **When can I put my bulk items out for pick up?**
  - Bulk items, mattresses and furniture within the Town of Selma are picked up on Monday by a garbage truck.
  - These items may be set out **no earlier than 7PM Sunday and no later than 7AM Monday** for collection. Property owners setting furniture out earlier than the stated time are subject to fines.
- **What do I do if I have an excessive amount of items?**
  - Residents can take excessive amounts of solid waste to the Johnston County landfill Monday-Saturday at the rate of \$35 per ton. A decal is not needed to dispose of waste at the Johnston County landfill.
