
- Community parade entries are FREE.

- Decorations on the box should not exceed 15" tall.
- Please, no electronics, food items, hazardous chemicals, or combustibles.
- Your float doesn't have to fit the theme suggestions but should be related to Black History Month and the Town of Selma in some way. Be creative and have fun!
- All submissions must be received by 4:30 pm on Monday, February 15th, 2021.
