The Selma Tourism Committee sponsored the creation of artwork depicting entertainment, shopping, and community events that was affixed to his building. Recently, Ron Hester volunteered a wall on his Railroad Street building and subsequently commissioned an eye-catching train mural on it for the enjoyment of those passing by on foot, in vehicles, or on Amtrak! Last month, the Triangle East Economic Development Foundation donated \$3000 to Activate Selma for additional murals!

Fire Department Inspects Seats

On September 22, Selma Fire Department hosted a free car seat assessment event along with Safe Kids Of Johnston County through Partnership For Children.

This program has been in place for 10 years but this was the first time it was held at the station.

The assessment of the car seats included positioning, proper fit, and whether the car seat was damaged or out of date. Twenty-seven vehicles were part of the assessment.

WE CAN'T HELP YOU IF WE CAN'T FIND YOU!!

Address numbers posted on your home are imperative to the services provided for you by the Town of Selma including fire, EMS, police, water, sewer, electric, zoning and many more. The Town of Selma ordinances REQUIRE that address numbers be posted at your residence or business. Numbers are required to be at least 3" tall and in a contrasting color to where they are posted. Numbers should be visible from the street and reflectivity is recommended.



Failure to post address numbers can result in a fine but more importantly, emergency services may be delayed in responding to an emergency.

Numbers may be purchased at local hardware stores, however, in order to assist citizens with their posting needs, the Selma Fire Department is currently taking orders for special reflective address plates available in several different colors.




