Backyard Fire Pits

Permanent and portable fire pits bring fire danger to your home. You can prevent fire or burn injury with these simple steps:

- Make sure the fire pit is at least three feet away from your house and anything that can burn.
- Closely watch children when the fire pit is in use.
- Use a metal screen over wood-burning fires to keep sparks from floating out.
- Turn off or put out fires before you leave the backyard.
- Store matches and lighters out of children's sight and reach.

Fogatas en el patio

Las fogatas permanentes y portátiles aumentan la probabilidad de ocurrencia de incendios. Puede prevenir un incendio o daño por quemaduras mediante estos sencillos pasos:

- Asegúrese que la fogata se encuentre como mínimo a tres pies de distancia de su hogar y de cualquier elemento que pueda incendiarse.
- Observe cuidadosamente a los niños cuando la fogata se encuentre en uso.
- Use una malla de metal sobre los fuegos hechos con leña para prevenir que las chispas se esparzan.
- Apague o extinga el fuego antes de abandonar el patio.
- Mantenga los fósforos y encendedores fuera de la vista y del alcance de los niños.

Grilling

Make safe outdoor cooking a priority.



- Move the grill away from siding, decking, and other things that can catch fire.
- Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill when it's hot.
- Stay with the grill the entire time you're cooking.
- Keep your grill clean so leftover grease and fat won't catch on fire.

Parrillas

Priorice cocinar de manera segura al aire libre.

- Mantenga la parrilla lejos del revestimiento de exteriores, terrazas de madera o cualquier otro elemento que pueda incendiarse.
- Mantenga a los niños y las mascotas a una distancia mínima de tres pies de la parrilla cuando esta se encuentre caliente.
- No se separe de la parrilla mientras esté cocinando.
- Mantenga la parrilla limpia para que la grasa y/o manteca sobrante no se incendie.



Summer months mean grilling! Make sure your home is protected.

Keep grills 3 feet away from your house and anything that can burn.
