Please put only the following listed materials into the recycling collection containers

PREPARATION: ❖ Just put clean, dry paper into the bin.	PREPARATION: ❖ Flatten boxes ❖ Remove plastic or waxed paper liners and all Styrofoam/peanuts packing material.	PREPARATION: ❖ Remove lids. ❖ Rinse to remove residue & let dry ❖ Do not break glass.	PREPARATION: ❖ Empty and rinse cans to remove all food residue ❖ Remove labels from tin cans.	PREPARATION: ❖ Rinse containers to remove residue & let dry before putting in the collection container
Items NOT Accepted: ❖ Wet, soiled or waxed paper ❖ Pizza boxes ❖ Used paper towels and plates ❖ Carbon paper ❖ Shredded paper ❖ Disposable cups	Items NOT Accepted: ❖ Wet, soiled or waxed cardboard ❖ Waxed coated beverage containers 	Items NOT Accepted: ❖ Light bulbs ❖ Window glass ❖ Drinking glasses ❖ Mirrors ❖ Ceramic items	Items NOT Accepted: ❖ Cans used for chemicals or paints ❖ Aerosol spray cans ❖ Small appliances, power tools or batteries ❖ Scrap metal/wood ❖ Cords, hoses, wires	Items NOT Accepted: ❖ Containers used for chemicals or automotive products (oil, antifreeze, etc.) ❖ Containers used for oil of any kind ❖ Rubber products ❖ Styrofoam cups and packing material ❖ Photographic film ❖ Plastic bags/wrap ❖ Polyvinyl sheeting ❖ Heat shrink wrapping

It is important to follow this chart!! If one item is placed in the truck that is not recyclable, the entire truck load is rejected. Then, it is all sent to the land fill. This also increases the cost of collection!!!
