I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The successful contractor will provide complete materials and installation, replacement or repair of fire hydrants and associated work to provide acceptable fire flow at various locations throughout town including all reasonable and necessary labor, supervision, equipment and supplies.

The Scope of Work is governed by the specifications described herein, the terms, conditions, and requirements found in this document and the firm's proposal especially the quoted project, duration, and work plan. Work will need to be scheduled during normal Town hours Monday-Friday 8-6p.m. No work will be done on Town holidays or outside business hours without the prior approval by the Town or its representative.

Once awarded the contract, the Contractor will actively coordinate project duration and provide a schedule to the Town of Selma, Water and Sewer Department to minimize, to the greatest extent possible, any operational/safety impacts.

II. SCOPE OF WORK

- 1) Installation of new hydrant and valve boxes

- 2) Remove and dispose of hydrant, vegetation, dirt, broken concrete, and any other debris as designated by the Town of Selma, Water and Sewer Department within the Construction Area.
- 3) Care of Property- Contractor shall be responsible for the proper custody and care of any property furnished by Town or any other site in conjunction with the project, for use in connection with the provisions of services.
- 4) Provide a safety plan and traffic control plan for the duration of the project to the Director of Water and Sewer.
- 5) The Contractor shall assign a competent resident superintendent who shall not be replaced without written notice to the Town of Selma except under extra-ordinary circumstances.
- 6) Contractor shall provide and assume full responsibility for all services, materials, equipment, labor, transportation, construction equipment and machinery, tools, appliances, fuel, power, light, heat, telephone, water, sanitary facilities, temporary facilities, and all other facilities and incidentals necessary for the performance, testing, start-up, and completion of work.
- 7) Unless otherwise agreed to by the Town of Selma, the site shall be free of equipment and materials each day.
- 8) However, in no case the Town of Selma will be responsible for any loss of equipment or materials. The Town of Selma shall be notified if an agreement with a property owner takes place during the duration of this project.
- 9) The contractor shall research and be responsible for obtaining, all regulatory, permitting, and licensing requirements.
- 10) The contractor shall confirm to all applicable construction codes, ordinances, and regulations including the national building code used in the local areal, laws and local ordinances. All work shall conform to the current regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Occupational Safety and Health. The regulations of the State of North Carolina and Johnston County shall apply if they are more stringent than those of the Federal Government.

III. General Standards

They Hydrant shall meet AWWA standards C502-14.

- Right turn open and left turn close.
- 5” Dry Barrell
- 4 ½ Steamer Connection NST
- Store connection on Steamer.
- 2 ½ Connection NST

Insertion Valve shall meet AWWA Standard C-515. 6” pipe.

IV. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Contractor, and all its subcontractors, shall not commence any services or perform any of its other obligations under this Agreement until Contractor obtains the insurance. All coverage shall be with insurance companies licensed and admitted to do business in the State of North Carolina. All coverages shall be with insurance carriers acceptable to the Town.

A. Worker’s Compensation Insurance: Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this Agreement, Worker’s Compensation Insurance, including Employers’ Liability Coverage either in accordance with all applicable statutes of the State of North Carolina.

B. Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance: Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance with limits of liability not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for Bodily Injury, and Property Damage. Coverage shall include all owned vehicles, all non-owned vehicles, and all hired vehicles.

C. Additional Insured: Commercial General Liability Insurance as described above, shall include an endorsement stating the following shall be additional insureds: “Town of Selma, all elected and appointed officials, all employees and volunteers, agents, all boards, commissions, and/or authorities and board members, including employees and volunteers thereof.” It is understood and agreed that, by naming the Town of Selma as additional insured, coverage afforded is considered to be primary and any other insurance the Town may have in effect shall be considered secondary and/or excess.
