

He began his career as a dispatcher in 2003 and completed BLET in 2007. During the next eleven years of his career with the Town of Selma, Chief Thomas served as Patrol Officer, Senior Officer, Patrol Sergeant, and Patrol Captain. He also received recognition as Selma Police Officer of the Year in 2010. In 2018, Thomas received his last and most honorable title as Chief of Police.



COLLECTIONS VIOLATIONS

CODE ENFORCEMENT WILL BE CONDUCTING ROUTINE INSPECTIONS OF COLLECTIONS AND REPORTING VIOLATIONS WITH THE USE OF COLOR-CODED TAGS.

EXCESSIVE

OVERFLOW IS <u>NOT</u> THE WAY TO GO!

CARTS WILL BE TAGGED WITH VIOLATION WARNINGS REGARDING EXCESSIVE TRASH FOUND IN AND/OR AROUND GARBAGE CART(S). EXCESSIVE TRASH MUST BE CONTROLLED BY RESIDENTS. THE FIRST WARNING WILL BE FOLLOWED BY A \$25 FINE.

IN THE EVENT EXCESSIVE TRASH IS FOUND FOLLOWING THE FIRST VIOLATION, AN ADDITIONAL GARBAGE CART WILL BE DELIVERED AND ADDED TO YOUR MONTHLY BILLING STATEMENT.

ADDITIONAL CARTS CAN BE ADDED AT ANYTIME BY VISITING TOWN HALL OR CONTACTING CUSTOMER SERVICE AT (919) 965-9841.



CHECK YOUR STASH BEFORE YOU TRASH!



IF YOUR RECYCLING IS FOUND TO INCLUDE CONTAMINATED WASTE, CHANCES ARE YOU WILL RECEIVE AN INITIAL WARNING IN THE FORM OF A YELLOW VIOLATION TAG AND A \$25 FINE.

IF YOUR RECYCLING IS FOUND TO HAVE BEEN CONTAMINATED A SECOND TIME, YOU WILL RECEIVE A FINAL NOTICE AND A SECOND \$25 FINE.

IN THE EVENT YOU CONTAMINATE RECYCLING A THIRD TIME, RECYCLING SERVICES WILL BE REVOKED AND YOUR RECYCLING CART WILL BE REMOVED.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT WE ONLY INCLUDE APPROVED RECYCLABLE ITEMS IN DESIGNATED RECYCLING CARTS. CONTAMINATED CARTS CAUSE CONTAMINATED LOADS AND THOSE CANNOT BE ACCEPTED AT RECYCLING FACILITIES.

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING INCLUDES

PLASTIC BOTTLES, TUBS, JARS & JUGS, METAL CANS, GLASS BOTTLES & JARS, PAPER, CARTONS & CARDBOARD

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED INCLUDE

FOOD, PLASTIC BAGS, BATTERIES, ELECTRONICS, CLOTHING, DIAPERS, DISPOSABLE CUPS, WIRES, STYROFOAM, WOOD, MEDICAL & HAZARDOUS WASTE, TIRES

BE SMART ABOUT YOUR CART!

BE SURE TO PLACE ALL COLLECTIONS BY THE ROAD AFTER 7:00 PM THE NIGHT BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED COLLECTIONS DAY.



VIOLATION TAGS WILL BE PLACED ON CARTS LEFT BY THE ROAD PAST THEIR SCHEDULED DAY OF PICKUP.

BE SURE TO RETURN ALL CARTS TO THEIR STORAGE AREAS BY 7:00 PM ON THE DAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED COLLECTIONS.

A \$25 FEE WILL ACCOMPANY EACH VIOLATION.
