NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TOWN OF SELMA FY 15/20 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

Notice is hereby given that the Town Council of the Town of Selma will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, March 12, 2024, at 6:00 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the agenda will allow, in the Selma Jernigan Building, 110 E. Anderson Street, Selma, NC 27576. Please visit the Town's website for more info at <u>https://selma-nc.com</u>. The purpose of the public hearing is to clarify the project area for the FY 15/20 Community Development Block Grant- Infrastructure (CDBG-I) Sewer Rehabilitation/Replacement Project and allow residents an opportunity to express their views. The total project budget remains unchanged at \$1,999,809 in CDBG-I funds (100% of total project costs) from NC Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Division of Water Infrastructure (DWI).

The initial project included rehabilitation/replacement of approximately 6,505 linear feet of aged/deteriorated 8inch diameter sewer line and rehabilitation of approx. thirty-three (33) manholes in the areas of E Dr. Martin Luther King Jr, S Pollock, E and W Preston, S Sellars, S Sharpe, S Webb, E and W Noble, E and W Watson, E Railroad, S Raiford, and W Jones streets. Construction bidding included rehabilitation of approximately 6,020 LF of 6-10" diameter gravity sewer line, rehab/replacement of approx. 18 manholes, replacement of approx. 145 sewer service reconnections, and replacement of approx. 4,305 LF of 4" sewer laterals with five (5) bid alternates within the original project area. Due to bid prices received, the construction scope will be reduced down to rehabilitation of approx. 1,817 LF of 8-10" diameter sewer line, rehabilitation of approx. eight (8) manholes, replacement of approx. 48 sewer service reconnections and approx. 1,680 4" sewer laterals, addressing segments by ranked percent serving low- and moderate-income (LMI) residential areas. The project will continue to benefit at least 51% LMI households, and therefore, 100% of the CDBG funds will be used to benefit LMI persons.

Persons having any questions concerning the CDBG-I Program are urged to attend the public hearing, make their views known, and submit comments. The project amendment package will be submitted to DWI within approx. two weeks after all required CDBG forms are executed. A public information file exists at Town Hall and may be viewed upon request.
