GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

****We welcome contestants that are beginners to pageants. If requested, we can provide interview and modeling training.****

Residence: Must reside within a 20-mile radius outside of Johnston County. Residence is defined as the primary address that you use to establish residency for your driver's license, automobile registration, tax filings, etc. Proof of Residency may be requested.

Personal Characteristics: Contestants must not be married nor have ever been married; must not be pregnant nor have ever been pregnant; must possess high moral standards. Social media posts as contestants and queens will be monitored to ensure you can represent Selma with the utmost integrity.

Duties: If selected to be on the court of the Selma Railroad Days Pageant, your actions and conduct will be representative of the integrity and esteem of the Town of Selma. You should acknowledge that you are an official representative of the Selma area and will be required to fulfill your list of duties presented to you upon obtaining your title. These duties consist of but are not limited to all Selma Railroad Days Festival functions on October 5th, the Selma Christmas Parade on December 3rd, and the 2025 Selma Railroad Days Pageant.

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

Opening Number: Contestants will be required to provide their own costume correlating to this year's pageant theme which will be presented later. You will not be judged during the opening number.

Interview: Attire requirement is a dressy outfit of your choice. This phase of the competition will focus on the ability to speak confidently, conduct a focused conversation, and portray one's individual personality. Interviews will be held at Town Hall on September 28th starting at 10am. Interview questions will pertain to information provided on your application or age-appropriate questions. At the start of the interview, please stand and self-introduce. Tiny and Little Miss contestant interviews will last 4 minutes, and the remaining divisions will last 6 minutes.

Evening Gown: Attire requirement is a party dress or semi-glitz pageant dress or evening gown and should be age appropriate. We are looking for confidence, beauty, and poise on stage and a lot of fun! Tiny Miss will compete in a short party dress and all other divisions will compete in a long evening gown.

Fun Fashion: Attire requirement is an outfit that shows your personal style: Fashionable Outfit, Pantsuit, Sundress, Cocktail, etc. (No hats, no jeans, no flip flops). This is an exciting and upbeat competition. It is important for one to have fun and show their true personality during this phase of the competition.

Talent (NOT required for Tiny Miss): This phase of the competition not only entertains the audience but allows you to showcase your natural talent in a 2–3-minute presentation. A piano is available with advance notice. Email the music to pageant@selma-nc.com by September 20th.

OPTIONAL (ALL AGES, \$10 fee to enter per photo) – Photogenic: All photogenic entries should be a headshot only (head or head & shoulders only), 8x10 or 8.5x11, and color or black & white. Photos are judged on overall personality, clarity, age appropriateness, and appearance. No full glitz photos are allowed. Light/minimal retouching is allowed. Due on September 27th at the dress rehearsal.

- Copy of birth certificate to verify age must be available if needed.
- Program Ad Sales information will be shared via email, website and social media soon.
- If crowned, winners will be required to pay **\$50** fee for car magnets for parades. Please pay the Pageant Director after crowning as they will be ordered the next day.
- Winners should also be prepared to wear red, white, or royal blue/combination dress or long jumpsuit for the Railroad Days Parade on Oct. 5th. The Queens will have a professional float.
