

LET'S BRUSH UP ON COLLECTIONS!

CODE ENFORCEMENT WILL BE CONDUCTING ROUTINE INSPECTIONS OF ALL COLLECTIONS. WARNINGS & VIOLATION FINES WILL BE ASSIGNED AS NEEDED!

GARBAGE CART LIDS MUST BE COMPLETELY CLOSED.

EXCESSIVE TRASH FINES WILL FOLLOW VIOLATIONS FOR OVERFLOWING CARTS. THIS INCLUDES THOSE UNABLE TO CLOSE COMPLETELY AND ANY FOUND WITH GARBAGE PILED AROUND THE EXTERIOR OF THE CART.

RECYCLING CARTS MUST NOT CONTAIN NON-RECYCLABLES.

NON-RECYCLABLES FOUND IN RECYCLING CARTS CONTAMINATE THE ENTIRE LOAD. VIOLATION FINES WILL BE CHARGED, AND CARTS WILL BE REMOVED FOLLOWING MULTIPLE FINDINGS OF CONTAMINATION.
PLEASE NOTE: RECYCLING CARTS ARE NOT ADDITIONAL GARBAGE CARTS.

CARTS MUST NOT BE PUT BY THE ROAD TOO EARLY OR LEFT OUT TOO LONG.

CARTS MUST BE IN PLACE THE NIGHT BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED COLLECTIONS DAY. THEY MUST BE RETURNED TO AN APPROPRIATE STORAGE LOCATION NO LATER THAN 7:00PM FOLLOWING COLLECTIONS.

METERS MUST NOT BE BLOCKED BY VEHICLES OR OTHER OBJECTS.

FINES WILL BE ADDRESSED TO THOSE BLOCKING UTILITY METERS. IMPROPERLY PLACED VEHICLES AND OTHER OBJECTS MAKE IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE UTILITY DEPARTMENT TO PULL A READ ON A METER. ENSURE YOU DO NOT PARK NEARBY OR ON YOUR METER OR THE METER OF YOUR NEIGHBOR.

CARTS MUST BE PLACED IN A PROPER LOCATION FOR COLLECTIONS AND MUST NOT BE BLOCKED BY OR PLACED TOO CLOSE TO OBJECTS.

CARTS MUST NOT BE MORE THAN 2 FEET FROM THE ROAD, THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 2 FEET OF SPACE AROUND EACH CART & THEY CANNOT BE BLOCKED BY VEHICLES OR OBJECTS! VIOLATIONS WILL BE ASSIGNED, AND BLOCKED GARBAGE/RECYCLING WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.

LEAF PILES MUST BE SEPARATE FROM OTHER YARD DEBRIS & GARBAGE.

PILES OF LEAVES FOUND TO HAVE STICKS AND OTHER OBJECTS HAVE CAUSED MAINTENANCE ISSUES WITH OUR NEW EQUIPMENT. PILES FOUND TO HAVE THESE OBJECTS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

NO TIRES, APPLIANCES OR LOOSE TRASH SHOULD BE PLACED BY THE ROAD! TOWN HALL MUST BE NOTIFIED OF BULK PICKUP REQUESTS!
