WEDNESDAY'S BULK WASTE & YARD DEBRIS WILL BE RETRIEVED ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 2ND.

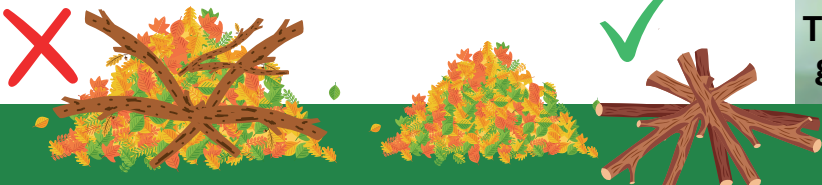


## LEAVES & YARD DEBRIS

BEFORE PERFORMING YARD MAINTENANCE, WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO BRUSH UP ON OUR YARD DEBRIS GUIDELINES TO KEEP OUR TRUCKS AND SCHEDULES RUNNING SMOOTHLY.

PILES OF YARD DEBRIS MUST ALWAYS BE SEPARATED. LIMBS AND OTHER ITEMS SHOULD NEVER BE MIXED IN WITH LEAVES. THIS DAMAGES EQUIPMENT AND TAKES TRUCKS OFF OF THE STREETS. BAGGED DEBRIS OR TRASH MUST BE DISPOSED OF WITHIN APPROPRIATE TRASH RECEPTACLE, NOT MIXED IN WITH PILES. DEBRIS THAT DOES NOT FOLLOW GUIDELINES COULD BE SKIPPED DURING COLLECTION ROUTES AND/OR GIVEN CODE VIOLATIONS.

PLEASE REMEMBER ONLY TWO SCOOPS OF YARD DEBRIS SHOULD BE PLACED BY THE ROAD AT A TIME. THIS IS APPROXIMATELY 12 CUBIC YARDS OF DEBRIS. PILES MUST NEVER BE PLACED TOO CLOSE TO OTHER ITEMS AND SHOULD BE NO MORE THAN TWO FEET FROM THE CURB.

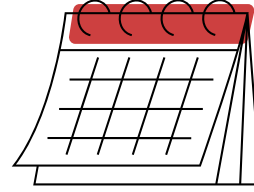

## WEATHER CAN FREEZE & BUST PIPES

- KNOW WHERE AND HOW TO SHUT OFF YOUR WATER FROM THE MAIN SHUT-OFF VALVE.
- SEAL AIR LEAKS AROUND PIPES THAT ALLOW COLD AIR TO SEEP IN.
- INSULATE PIPES NEAR OUTER WALLS, IN CRAWL SPACES OR IN ATTICS.
- DISCONNECT GARDEN HOSES, SHUT OFF AND DRAIN WATER FROM PIPES LEADING OUTSIDE. CONSIDER INSTALLING AN INSULATED SPIGOT COVER.
- TURN YOUR FAUCET ON JUST ENOUGH TO HAVE CONSTANT DRIPPING (FOR PIPES THAT MAY BE ON EXTERIOR WALL)
- OPEN CABINET DOORS TO ALLOW HEAT TO CIRCULATE AROUND PIPES UNDER A SINK.
- LEAVE HEAT ON AND SET NO LOWER THAN 55 DEGREES.
- IF YOU PLAN TO BE AWAY FROM HOME, HAVE SOMEONE CHECK ON YOUR HOUSE DAILY.
- CLOSE FOUNDATION VENTS IF THE TEMPERATURE DROPS BELOW FREEZING FOR A SIGNIFICANT PERIOD OF TIME. RE-OPEN WHEN WEATHER WARMS.

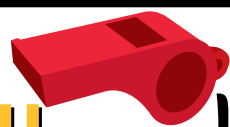

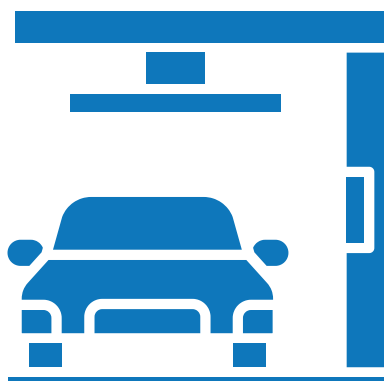

**Q: What do permits cost?**

A: Planning and Zoning department fees can be easily viewed on our website by clicking on the Planning and Economic Development tab then clicking "Permits & Fees".

**Q: What are the most common types of permits?**

- Zoning Permit – Residential / Commercial
- Signs – Temporary / Permanent
- Commercial Use / Change / Tenant
- Special Use Permits
- Certificate of Appropriateness
- Special Event Permit

**Q: How are permits issued?**

A: Permits are issued based on the type of work to be performed. Initial information in the application and site plans can provide details for review. Items such as reviewing the appropriate setbacks or property lines, water and sewer easements, streets/sidewalks, accessory structures, and such. When possible, a site plan should always accompany the application.

**Q: What is the zoning of my piece of property?**

A: You can find the zoning of your property by using our GIS MapClick interface. This interface is available on the web at [www.johnstonnc.com/gis](http://www.johnstonnc.com/gis). From the MapClick GIS Application, you can locate your parcel, and then query the zoning information. Or, alternatively, you can send an email to [planning-department@selma-nc.com](mailto:planning-department@selma-nc.com) or by calling (919)965-9841 ext. 1022.

**Q: What's the difference between a Zoning Permit and a Building Permit?**

A: Most development is regulated under two different codes: the zoning code (Unified Development Code) and the Building Code. Receiving a Zoning Permit is generally the first step in the development process, followed by applying for and receiving a building permit.

**Q: Should I complete my project and then apply for a permit?**

A: The answer is **NO**. Always apply for a permit and wait for final approval before moving forward with any permit required projects.

**Q: Is a permit required if there is a tenant change for/at a business?**

A: The answer is YES! There is no fee for the change in tenant permit, but it is required for fire inspection safety reasons.

**Q: Did you know that if you're planning to change your business use that a change in use permit is required?**

A: For example, if your business currently operates as a retail store but you're wanting to change to a coffee shop or office, you will need to apply for a change in use permit.
