**2025-013-O: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWN OF SELMA RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD BYLAWS WITHIN CHAPTER TWO OF THE TOWN OF SELMA MUNICIPAL CODE**

- WHEREAS,** The Town of Selma Administration has initiated text amendments to the Bylaws governing the Recreation Advisory Board due to the athletic, seasonal demand for Parks and Recreation events and activities; and
- WHEREAS,** Staff has proposed to limit the meeting schedule to quarterly to better accommodate the needs of the department. Staff also understand the Board has the authority to call special meetings as needed in accordance with state legislature; and
- WHEREAS,** on June 10, 2025, during regular session, the Town of Selma Town Council unanimously approved to amend the Recreation Advisory Board's bylaws as presented.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:**

**Section 1.** The Town of Selma Town Code is hereby amended to read:

**Sec. 2-48. – Meetings of the Recreation Advisory Board**

- a) Regular meetings of the Recreation Advisory Board shall be held at 6:00pm on the third Tuesdays of ~~February, May, August, and November.~~ each month Recreation Advisory Board meetings ~~and~~ shall be held in the Jernigan Building. If a scheduled meetings falls on a Holiday where Town offices are closed, the meeting shall automatically be rescheduled to the following Tuesday,

**Section 2.** The Official Code of the Town of Selma shall now reflect the amendment referenced herein.

**Section 3.** The Clerk is hereby authorized to insert such amendments into the official Code of Ordinances of the Town of Selma and keep them on files in the Office of the Clerk.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
