

## RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Town of Selma will receive separate sealed formal bids for the **Selma Water Distribution and Capacity Expansion (SRP-D-ARP-0096) Project** at the Selma Town Hall, located at 212 N. Raiford Street, Selma, NC 27576, until **Thursday, September 11, 2025, 2:00 PM**, local prevailing time, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids may be submitted by mail or courier. While there is an option to attend the Bid Opening virtually, hardcopy bids are still required to be received.

The project will consist of upgrading (4) Well Sites including well head, building, electrical, site work, and abandonment of (1) existing well. Additionally, 4,369 LF of 6-inch PVC C900 raw water main will be installed by open cut, 2,511 LF of 8-inch PVC C900 raw water main will be installed by open cut, 350 LF of 8-inch FPCS C900 raw water main via Horizontal Direction Drill, 50 LF Bore and Jack- 16-inch Steel Casing with 8-inch DIP PC Carrier Pipe including connections to the existing raw water mains, clearing and grubbing, erosion control measures, removal and replacement of asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalks, driveways, curb & gutter, and site restoration. The project will also include the installation of approximately 4,603 LF of 8-inch PVC C900 potable water main by open cut, 80 LF of DIP PC350 potable water main by open cut, 340 LF of 8-inch FPVC C900 potable water main by horizontal directional drill, 320 LF of 16-inch steel casing with 8-inch DIP PC350 potable water main by bore and jack, 5,716 LF of 6-inch PVC C900 potable water main by open cut, 1,105 LF of 6-inch DIP PC350 potable water main by open cut, 72 LF of 4-inch DIP PC350 potable water main by open cut, 81 LF of 2-inch PVC ASTM 2241, SDR21 water main by open cut, and all associated appurtenances, valves, hydrants, and services.

Please note that the PWS Authorization to Construct is still pending. Construction on this project shall not commence until this approval is received.

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on **Thursday, July 10, 2025** and is included in the Addenda. Bidders are responsible for ensuring receipt of their bid by the stated date and time. Bidders are responsible for the review of the addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form.

Bidders are responsible for the review of any addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form. All bids must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of 5% of the total amount bid made

payable to the Owner. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of **90 consecutive calendar days** after bid opening except as provided in Information for Bidders. Bidders must show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bid Documents as required by the North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 87. The Owner reserves the right to reject any/all bids, to waive formalities, or to reject non-conforming, non-responsive, or conditional bids. The Owner reserves the right to award a contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder or bidders, taking into consideration quality, performance, and time.

This project is a portion of an approximate \$6.5M American Rescue Plan Act grant administered by the NC Division of Water Infrastructure.

The Owner is an Equal Opportunity Employer and encourages bidding by qualified small (SBE), minority and female (M/WBE), disadvantaged (DBE), and historically underutilized (HUB) contractors and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, handicap/disability, age, or familial status.
