We are excited to announce that for the first time ever, there will be Baby and Wee Miss age divisions!! The pageant will be split into two parts. The 10:00am pageant will be for Baby Miss through Tiny Miss contestants. The 5:00pm pageant will be for Little Miss through Miss contestants.

GENERAL REOUIREMENTS:

We welcome contestants that are beginners to pageants. If requested, we can provide interview and modeling training.

Residence: Must reside within a 30-mile radius outside of Johnston County. Residence is defined as the primary address that you use to establish residency for your driver's license, automobile registration, tax filings, etc. Proof of Residency may be requested.

Personal Characteristics: Contestants must not be married nor have ever been married; must not be pregnant nor have ever been pregnant; must possess high moral standards. Social media posts as contestants and queens will be monitored to ensure you can represent Selma with the utmost integrity.

Duties: If selected to be on the court of the Selma Railroad Days Pageant, your actions and conduct will be representative of the integrity and esteem of the Town of Selma. You should acknowledge that you are an official representative of the Selma area and will be required to fulfill your list of duties presented to you upon obtaining your title. These duties consist of but are not limited to Selma Railroad Days Festival on October 4th, the Selma Christmas Parade on December 2nd, various town council meetings, and the 2026 Selma Railroad Days Pageant.

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

Opening Number: Contestants will be required to provide their own costume correlating to this year's pageant theme which will be presented later. Opening number is not judged.

Interview (NOT required for Baby, Wee, or Tiny Miss): Attire requirement is a dressy outfit of your choice. This phase of the competition will focus on the ability to speak confidently, conduct a focused conversation, and portray one's individual personality. Interviews will be held at Town Hall on September 27th starting at 2:00pm. Interview questions will pertain to information provided on your emcee sheet or age-appropriate questions. At the start of the interview, please stand, self-introduce, and then sit in front of the panel of judges. Contestant interviews will last 6 minutes.

Evening Gown: Attire requirement is a party dress or semi-glitz pageant dress or evening gown and should be age appropriate. We are looking for confidence, beauty, and poise on stage and a lot of fun! Baby, Wee, and Tiny Miss will compete in a short party/pageant dress and all other divisions will compete in a long evening gown.

Fun Fashion: Attire requirement is an outfit that shows your personal style: Fashionable Outfit, Pantsuit, Sundress, Cocktail, etc. (No hats, no jeans, no flip flops). This is an exciting and upbeat competition. It is important for one to have fun and show their true personality during this phase of the competition.

Talent (<u>NOT</u> required for Baby, Wee, or Tiny Miss): This phase of the competition not only entertains the audience but allows you to showcase your natural talent in a presentation no longer than 3 minutes. A piano is available with advance notice. Email the music to <u>pageant@selma-nc.com</u> by September 19th. Must be MP3 or M4A format.

OPTIONAL (ALL AGES, \$10 fee to enter per photo) – Photogenic: All photogenic entries should be a headshot only (head or head & shoulders only), 8x10 or 8.5x11, and color or black & white. Photos are judged on overall personality, quality, and age appropriateness. If multiple photos are entered, the highest scoring photo will be submitted for the Photogenic category. One overall photogenic winner per pageant will be awarded. This optional category has no bearing on division winners. No full glitz photos are allowed. Light/minimal retouching is allowed. Due on September 26th at the dress rehearsal.

- There will only be <u>ONE</u> chaperone allowed in changing area with each contestant but no men will be permitted. This <u>DOES NOT</u> provide any chaperones with a seat in the audience. If a seat is needed, it must be purchased. The changing area is <u>VERY</u> limited. Please arrive at the pageant with hair and makeup ready for opening number.
- Copy of birth certificate to verify age must be available if needed.
- Score sheets will be given out after the pageant.
- Program Ad Sales information will be shared via email at the Meet and Greet.
- If crowned, winners will be required to pay \$50 fee for car magnets for parades. Please pay the Pageant Director after crowning as they will be ordered the next day.
- Winners should also be prepared to wear red, white, or royal blue/combination dress or long jumpsuit for the Selma Railroad Days Parade on Oct. 4th. The Queens will be provided with a professional float.
