Selma Christmas Parade

Thank you for your interest in participating in this years Selma Christmas Parade. Before applying, we recommend you take a moment to read the following guidelines and regulations. We look forward to receiving your application.

Parade Course: Begin on East Richardson Street where it will cross over NC 301 and turn right onto N. Raiford Street. The parade will continue on N. Raiford Street until turning left onto East Anderson Street and then turning left onto Webb Street where it will end.

Line-Up Begins: Tuesday, December 2nd at 6:00 p.m. (Please DO NOT arrive early)

Line-Up Location: Selma Elementary School Parking Lot

Selma Christmas Committee members will be throughout the lineup area to assist you in locating your position and direct you out of the staging area.

All entries must be in place and ready to leave the staging area by 6:45 p.m. If you are NOT in place by 6:45, you will be put in the back of the lineup.

Line-up Assignments: The contact person on the parade application will be emailed or called, on or before Friday, November 28th to notify you of your line-up placement and number.

Additional parking is not allowed in the lineup area at Selma Elementary School. Please ensure parents and others know this prior to dropping off. Rules & Regulations

Limited spaces are available and entries are generally accepted on a first come, first serve basis. The Town of Selma reserves the right to accept or deny any entry application.

The parade will not be cancelled due to weather conditions unless severe. Come prepared for rain, cold or heat.

All floats and vehicles must be decorated in a Christmas Theme.

This is an evening parade and the use of Christmas lights is strongly encouraged.

The Selma Parks and Recreation Department reserves the sole right to use the character of Santa Claus for the final parade entry. Other Santa entries WILL NOT be permitted in the parade.

Do not tailgate or leave gaps! Keep about four car lengths (approx. 50 feet) between each entry at all times and drive no faster than 5 mph.

This is a family event; therefore, participants may not act in a lewd manner and shall dress appropriately.

No animals will be allowed in the parade unless approved by the Selma Christmas Committee prior to the parade. If approved, your entry will be placed at the end of the parade.

It is the responsibility of parents with children participating in the parade to make necessary arrangements to have children met and picked up at designated points.

All marching, dancing, or performing art units are to keep moving. You are allowed to stop to perform routines for 60 seconds one time.

Sound systems should be placed with the speakers facing the sides of the entry so that maximum sound will reach the audience with minimum interference to entries preceding and following yours.

Camera, video and mobile phone use by participants is discouraged. You are there to entertain others, not to be entertained.

- The Town of Selma reserves the right to deny participation from any person and/or vehicle which appears to be unsafe to participate. The Town of Selma reserves the right to request modifications to any parade entry and/or positioning of people, which appear to be unsafe.
- Limited spaces are available, and entries are generally accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Town of Selma reserves the right to accept or deny any entry application.
- The parade will not be canceled due to weather conditions. Come prepared for rain, cold, or heat.
- Do not tailgate or leave gaps! Always keep about four car lengths (approx. 50 feet) between each entry and drive no faster than 5 mph.
- This is a family event; therefore, participants may not act in a lewd manner and shall dress appropriately.
- It is the responsibility of parents with children participating in the parade to make necessary arrangements to have children met and picked up at designated points.
- All marching, dancing, or performing art units are to keep moving. You can stop in front of the reviewing stand at Anderson and Raiford Street.
- Sound systems should be placed with the speakers facing the sides of the entry so that maximum sound will reach the audience with minimum interference to entries preceding and following yours.
- Refunds will not be given for any reason once monies are paid.
- New state/municipal regulations that are established before the event must also be adhered to in addition to these regulations.
- Liability release will be provided prior to the event and must be signed before a position is assigned.
