'Tis the Season to Stay Fire-Safe!

- PLUG ONLY 1 HEAT-PRODUCING APPLIANCE INTO AN OUTLET AT A TIME-
- KEEP PORTABLE GENERATORS OUTSIDE, AWAY FROM WINDOWS AND STRUCTURES-
- INSTALL & TEST CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH-
- KEEP ANYTHING THAT CAN BURN AT LEAST 3 FEET FROM ANY HEAT SOURCE-
- PLACE ONE SMOKE ALARM ON EVERY FLOOR AND SLEEPING ROOM-
- HAVE A PROFESSIONAL CLEAN & INSPECT YOUR CHIMNEY AND VENTS ANNUALLY-



DON'T LET THE BURST YOUR BUBBLE – OR YOUR PIPES!

- VALVE-READY! – KNOW WHERE AND HOW TO SHUT OFF YOUR MAIN WATER.
- SEAL THE CHILL – BLOCK COLD AIR FROM SNEAKING AROUND YOUR PIPES.
- BUNDLE UP PIPES – INSULATE THOSE NEAR OUTER WALLS, ATTICS, OR CRAWL SPACES.
- HOSE OFF! – DISCONNECT GARDEN HOSES, DRAIN EXTERIOR PIPES, AND TRY AN INSULATED SPIGOT COVER.
- DRIP, DRIP, HOORAY! – LET FAUCETS ON EXTERIOR WALLS DRIP JUST ENOUGH TO STAY SAFE.
- OPEN SESAME – KEEP CABINET DOORS OPEN TO LET WARM AIR REACH SINK PIPES.
- TURN UP THE HEAT – DON'T LET YOUR HOME DROP BELOW 55°F.
- HOUSE WATCH – IF YOU'RE AWAY, HAVE SOMEONE CHECK ON YOUR HOME DAILY.
- VENT WISELY – CLOSE FOUNDATION VENTS DURING DEEP FREEZES; REOPEN WHEN IT WARMS UP.



IF YOUR PIPES FREEZE: SHUT OFF WATER VALVES. STOPPING THE FLOW OF WATER CAN MINIMIZE THE DAMAGE TO YOUR HOME.

LEAVES & YARD DEBRIS

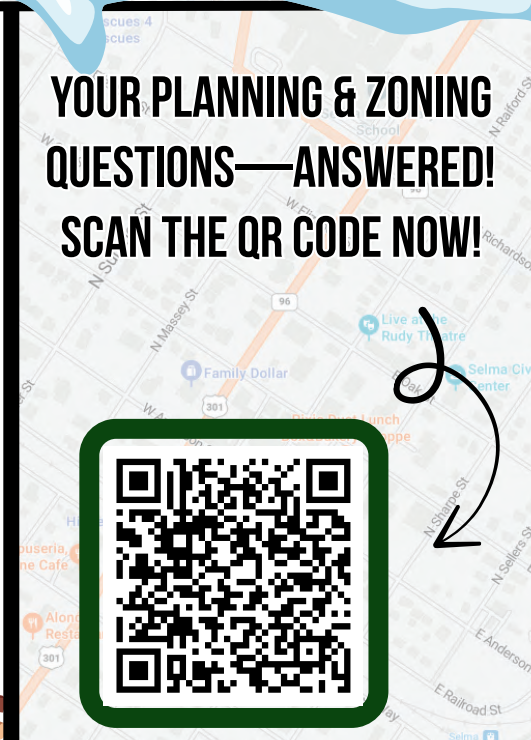
BEFORE PERFORMING YARD MAINTENANCE, WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO BRUSH UP ON OUR YARD DEBRIS GUIDELINES TO KEEP OUR TRUCKS AND SCHEDULES RUNNING SMOOTHLY.

PILES OF YARD DEBRIS MUST ALWAYS BE SEPARATED. LIMBS AND OTHER ITEMS SHOULD NEVER BE MIXED IN WITH LEAVES. THIS DAMAGES EQUIPMENT AND TAKES TRUCKS OFF OF THE STREETS. BAGGED DEBRIS OR TRASH MUST BE DISPOSED OF WITHIN APPROPRIATE TRASH RECEPTACLE, NOT MIXED IN WITH PILES. DEBRIS THAT DOES NOT FOLLOW GUIDELINES COULD BE SKIPPED DURING COLLECTION ROUTES AND/OR GIVEN CODE VIOLATIONS.

PLEASE REMEMBER ONLY TWO SCOOPS OF YARD DEBRIS SHOULD BE PLACED BY THE ROAD AT A TIME. THIS IS APPROXIMATELY 12 CUBIC FEET OF DEBRIS. PILES MUST NEVER BE PLACED TOO CLOSE TO OTHER ITEMS AND SHOULD BE NO MORE THAN TWO FEET FROM THE CURB.



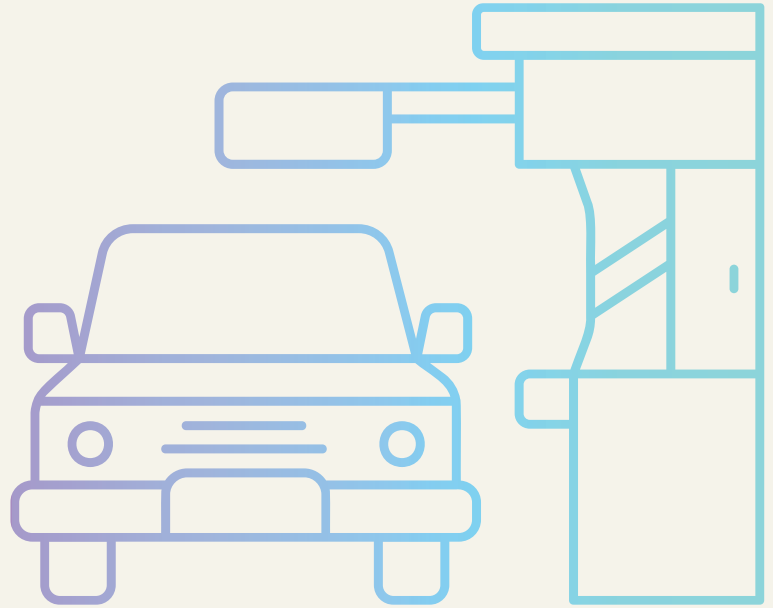
