IF YOU SEE A DAMAGED STREET SIGN, DRAINAGE ISSUE, POTHOLE, OR WATER LEAK, PLEASE CONTACT TOWN HALL. YOUR CALL HELPS US RESPOND QUICKLY AND KEEP SELMA RUNNING SMOOTHLY.

- PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION, EXTERIOR ADDITIONS, FENCES AND ACCESSORY BUILDINGS.
- IF YOUR PROPERTY IS WITHIN A HISTORIC DISTRICT, ANTICIPATE AN ADDITIONAL REVIEW PROCESS AND NEEDED PERMIT FOR MOST EXTERIOR CHANGES.

IF YOU'RE PLANNING A PROJECT THIS SPRING, WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO CONTACT TOWN HALL BEFORE BEGINNING WORK.

BULK PICKUP ITEMS MEANS HOUSEHOLD FURNITURE EXCLUDING ELECTRONICS, ELECTRICAL DEVICES, AND APPLIANCES.



APPROPRIATE BULK PICKUP ITEMS

Inside The Home

- Test your home's smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. Change the batteries.
- Don't use electrical appliances with frayed cords.
- Check for water around electrical appliances.
- Clean debris from your clothes dryer lint trap & exhaust duct.

Outside The Home

- Remove dead leaves & other debris around foundations, decks, porches, & stairs.
- Check grills for rust, worn parts, insects, grease, & other debris before use.
- Grills should only be used when at least 10 feet away from your house or any building.
