The Town of Selma will receive separate sealed formal bids for the **Selma Water System Improvements (SRP-D-134-0009) Phase 2** at Selma Town Hall, located at **212 North Raiford Street, Selma, NC 27576** until **Thursday, July 2, 2026 at 10:30 AM**, local prevailing time, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids may be submitted by mail or courier. While there is an option to attend the Bid Opening virtually, hardcopy bids are still required to be received.

The project will consist of furnishing, erecting, painting, testing, and disinfection of one (1) 500,000 gallon multi-leg elevated storage tank including site work, grading, erosion control, altitude valve vault, outlet structure, and site piping as specified and shown on the drawings. The bid shall also include the design, furnishing, and construction of the tank foundation based on the provided subsurface investigation, specifications, and special provisions. Additionally, the project will include approximately 75 LF of 12" C900 PVC and 5 LF of 12" DIP PC350 off-site potable water main and all associated valves and appurtenances to connect the elevated storage tank to the existing water system.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **Thursday, June 4, 2026 at 10:00 AM**, local time, virtually, and at the Selma Town Hall, located at 212 North Raiford Street, Selma, NC 27576. Interested parties are encouraged to attend this conference to review the plans, ask for additional information or clarification, and to visit the project site. Attendance at the Pre-Bid-Conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Bidders are responsible for ensuring receipt of their bid by the stated date and time. Bidders are responsible for the review of any addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form. To qualify, all bids shall be submitted using bid forms contained in the Contract Documents. Incomplete or segregated bids will not be accepted. All bids must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of 5% of the total amount bid made payable to the Owner. The bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful bidder fails to execute contracts or fails to provide the required bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after the proper notice of award of the contract. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of **60 consecutive calendar days** after bid opening except as provided in Information for Bidders. Bidders must show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bid Documents as required by the North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 87. The Owner reserves the right to reject any/all bids, to waive formalities, or to reject non-conforming, non-responsive, or conditional bids. The Owner reserves the right to award a contract to the

lowest, responsive, responsible bidder or bidders, taking into consideration quality, performance, and time.

This project is funded by a portion of \$12.6M State Reserve funds established in S.L. 2023-134 administered by the NC Division of Water Infrastructure.

The Owner is an Equal Opportunity Employer and encourages bidding from small, minority and female (M/WBE), disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) and historically underutilized businesses (HUB). Bidders shall be required to submit with their Bids affidavits of "Good Faith Efforts" in the recruitment of MBEs.
